



PC5 Western Pyrenees Circular Tour

From the verdant hills which rise up from the Bay of Biscay this adventure will take you into the high, rocky Pyrenees. You'll find gorges and immense native woodlands, desert landscapes, and Ordesa & Monte Perdido, Posets-Maladeta - two of Spain's most spectacular National Parks.

There are lovely villages and towns to discover; Urdax and Ochagavia in Navarra, medieval Uncastillo, Ainsa, Alquézar and Huesca itself. Of course the mountains are the star, with fantastic walking, scenery and wildlife throughout, but here you'll also find delicious regional dishes and fine local wines and a surprisingly rich architectural heritage - a real treasure trove, full of Romanesque gems.

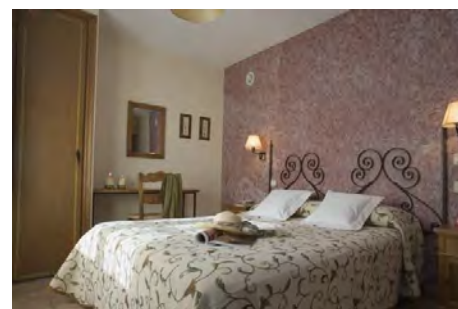
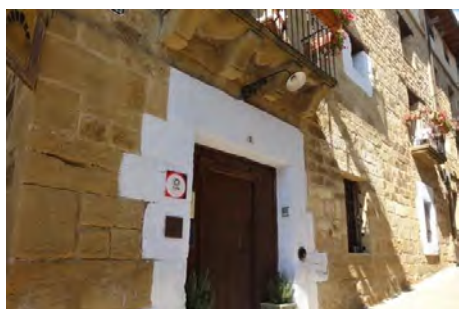
Accommodation: 1 x Double room with balcony, Bed & Breakfast

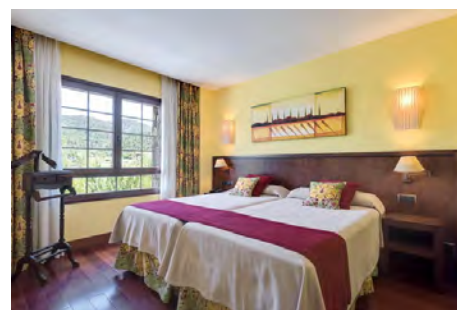
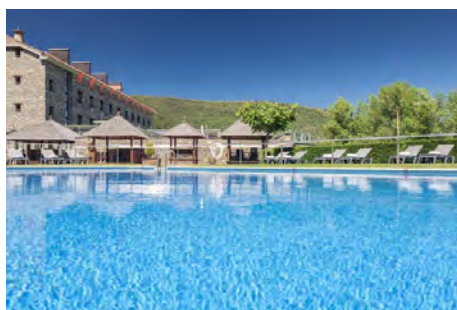

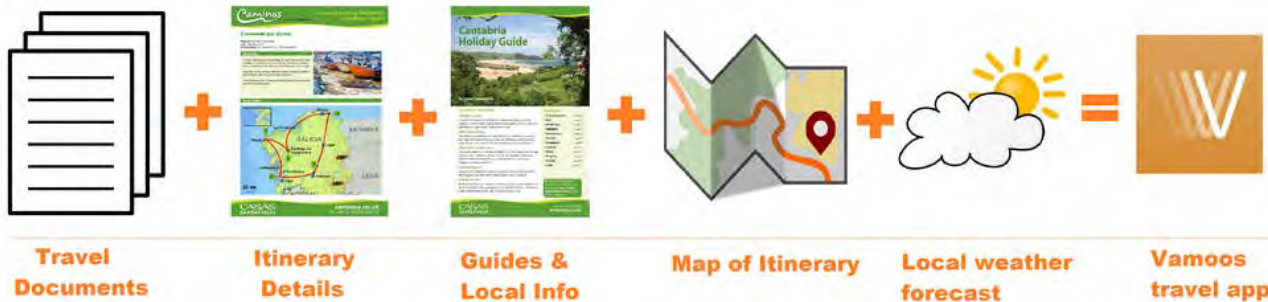
The 20 fully-equipped rooms all have en-suite bathrooms and are decorated in a surprisingly modern style, making a feature where possible of the building's historical charm.
