



CT2 Coastal Catalonia - Cami de Ronda

From the rugged Costa Brava down to the sun-kissed beaches of the Costa Dorada, and onwards to the unique eco-system of the Ebro Delta, the Catalan coastline offers the very best of Mediterranean Spain.

Walk the Camí de Ronda coastal path, explore the many delights of Barcelona and the spectacular Roman remains of Tarragona, savour the Cava in the Penedés, watch the flamingos in the Delta and finish up with the fine wines of Priorat - all without straying far from the sunny Mediterranean!

With frequent flights to Girona and Reus from most UK airports this one-way Catalan road trip packs in so many highlights you may struggle to find time for the beach!

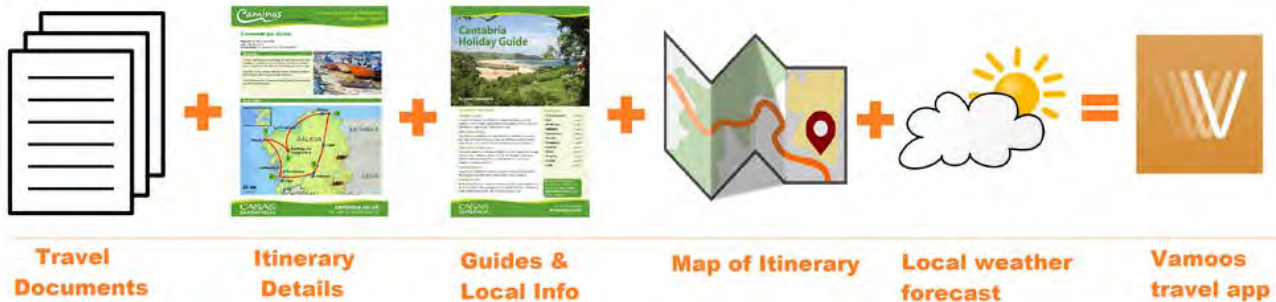
